- Malaria tablets are not available on the NHS. There is a £10.00 fee for issuing a private prescription for malaria prophylaxis. Please note you will still need make payment at the chemist for your tablets
- Travel certificates incur a charge of £10.00
- Form needs to be completed 6-8 weeks before travelling.

Travel vaccinations available

Please note: patients that are not registered with this practice will have to pay for all vaccinations.

Cholera (Dukoral)	2 years	Free	At least a week before travel date
Diphtheria Tetanus Polio (Revaxis)	10 years	Free	Few days before travel date
Diphtheria Tetanus Polio Whooping cough (repevax)		Free	Few days before travel date
Hepatitis A (Avaxim)	Long term	Free	Few days before travel date
Hepatitis A & B (Twinrix)	10-20 years	Free	6 weeks before travel date
Hepatitis A & B – for children (Twinrix paed)	10-20 years	Free	6 weeks before travel date
Hepatitis B (Engerix-B/HBVaxPro)	10 Years	£35 per dose	1 month before travel date
Influenza (flu) (inactivated influenza vaccine)	1 year	£15 per dose	1 month before travel date
Menigitis (Nimenrix)	5 years	£55 per dose	Few days before travel date
MMR-Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMRVaxPro)	11 years	£40 per dose	Few days before travel date
Rabies intramuscular, course of 3 doses (Verorab/RabiesVaccineBP)	3-4 years	£55 per dose	1 month before travel date
Rabies Booster intramuscular, single dose (Verorab/RabiesVaccineBP)	3-4 years	£55 per dose	Few days before travel date
Typhoid injection (vivotif)	3 years	Free	Few days before travel date
Typhoid tablets (vivotif)	1 year	Free	15 days before travel date
Typhoid & Hepatitis A (Viatim)	*See notes	Free	4 weeks before travel date
Yellow Fever including FREE yellow fever certificate (staminl)	10 years	£55 per dose	10 days before travel date

- Note typhoid injection will last 3 years. Hepatitis A – booster usually recommended 6-12 months
