Intensive Pastoral and nurturing support Referral: Education

MULTI-AGENCY

Assessment and planning to support C/YP



SOCIAL WORK

Involuntary or intensive support (e.g. Family Functional Therapy)

Referral: Request for Assistance



EDUCATIONAL PSYCHOLOGY SERVICE

Ongoing support to contribute to planning around a child's education

Referral: Education



CAMHS

Intensive: outpatient support
Highly specialised: Involuntary or intensive support
(e.g. Skye House, Safety Planning)

Referral: GP
