Life threatening anaphylaxis is a severe reaction to allergens such as food, insect stings, medication & latex

The body thinks it is fighting something which shouldn't be there and sends out special chemicals to fight back.









People may experience mild or moderate symptoms including:

- **⊘** Itchy skin rash
- Swelling of lips, face or eyes

What are the signs of a severe allergic reaction?

- O Difficult to breathe/noisy breathing



- 1. A severe allergic reaction can become serious quickly so a special adrenaline pen must be used immediately
- 2. Then call 999 and tell them the person is suffering from anaphylaxis (anna-fill-axis)
