Getting here

Location

Salford Civic Centre is on Chorley Road (A6) in the centre of Swinton at its junction with Partington Lane (B5231).

Bike

Short-stay cycle parking is available between Unity House and the Civic Centre. Covered cycle parking is available at the rear of Unity House and the rear of the Civic Centre.

Bus

Salford Civic Centre is served by the 29, 36, 37 and 38 buses.

Train

Salford Civic Centre is a 6-minute walk from Swinton Railway Station.

Parking

There is a car park in front of Unity House. Visitors must obtain a ticket and display this on their windscreen.
