

Meeting Purpose

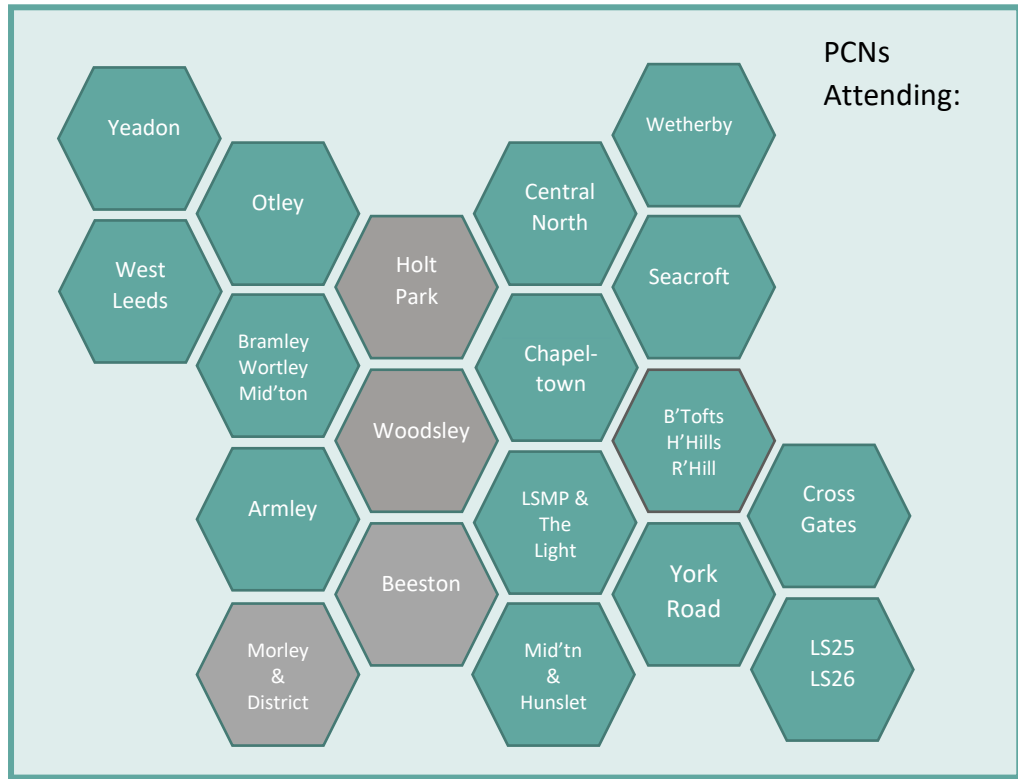

LTHT Patient Hub – Rob Child	For Information Rob Child presented the LTHT Patient Hub implemented in 2022. This included the background, purpose and changes made. The Board welcomed the initiative.
Cancer Support Services	For Discussion The service explained immanent cessation of the service and potential impacts. The discussion focussed on how to mitigate impacts. To be fed back to the Cancer Population Board for consideration.
Strategy Development Session 3	For Decision The final strategy including purpose, strategic, objectives and priorities alongside organisational priorities was presented and approved.
