# Support Groups

Each group is different and members decide what activities they want to do. Every group has a support worker from the

Centre who helps organise speakers, meeting rooms, organises tea and coffee as well as pass on information and help in any way possible with problems or contact another member of staff who is more able to help.

### **Alcohol Support Group**
