	receiving them on prescriptions was raised. This had happened		
	during a medication review.		
	AD informed the meeting that NHS England was moving towards		
	a self-care system where patients would be encouraged to		
	supply their own medication. There were also trial projects		
	running with referral systems to Pharmacies.		
	There appears to be an issue with the Hospital Transport System.		
	One patient had their 4.30 appointment cancelled because they		
	were using the free Hospital Transport.
