
Flu Jabs 2023

Flu jab clinics start mid-September at the Practice. We have ordered enough jabs for all our eligible patients. Please support your GP Surgery (and to avoid wasted vaccine).

Flu clinics will run throughout the autumn and winter months and our first Saturday clinic will be 16th September. We have clinics running throughout the week too (including early mornings, throughout the day and evenings).

We are booking now. Text invitations are being sent to patients. If you haven't received one, please contact us.



This year's eligibility is as follows:

- Those aged 65 years and over (born before 1st April 1959)
 - * Respiratory disease
- * Heart/vascular disease
 - * Kidney disease
 - * Liver disease
- * Neurological disease
 - Diabetes/adrenal insufficiency
- * Immunosuppession (due to disease or treatment)
- * Asplenia or dysfunction of the spleen
 - * Obesity (BMI ≥40 kg/m²)
- Those aged 6 months to under 65 years in clinical risk groups
- Pregnant women
- Children aged 2 or 3 years on 31 August 2023
- Children (4—18 years but, only those in a clinical risk group should be jabbed at the surgery)
- Those in long-stay residential care homes
- Carers receiving carer's allowance, or are the main carer of an elderly or disabled person
- close contacts of immunocompromised individuals.

Autumn COVID Jab

The next COVID campaign is due to start in October. Eligible patients are:

- over 65 years
- in a clinical risk group (over 6 months old)
- Household contacts of those with immunosuppression
- Carers
- Frontline health & social care workers.

Surgery Activity

GP Practices and other healthcare services are experiencing unprecedented demand. We are working really hard to ensure patients receive our healthcare services in an appropriate and timely manner.



As reported by Appointments in General Practice - NHS Digital (Jul 22—Feb 23), EPCC's total appointments per 1000 patients was 622 compared to the national average of 456. 320 of those appointments were with a GP, compared to NHSE average of 218.

NHS Help with Weight Management
