Self -care

If you have a cough or cold. graze or upset stomach you can treat these symptoms at home-in fact staying at home and getting plenty of rest is the best place for you

Pharmacy

Your pharmacist is a qualified clinician who can help you with common health problems including sore throat, diarrhoea and headache

General practice (GP) doctor's surgery

Whether you feel ill or not it is essential that you register with a GP local to you. Registering is easy and means you have access to a doctor 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. You should visit your GP for injuries and ongoing illnesses, they will also be able to assess your needs and refer you to a specialist if needed If your GP surgery is closed call 111 for out of hours advice.

Urgent care centre

Use these centres if you have an urgent and severe, but not life threatening, illness or health problem including wounds, cuts and sprains.

Accident and Emergency (A&E)

These are hospital emergency centres and treat people with life threatening injuries or illness, for example

- · Loss of consciousness
- Very confused state and fits that are not stopping
- Persistant and severe chest pain
- Severe bleeding that cannot be stopped.
